Here are several points of information that should be of use to you.

1) The program in its final form, except for locations on campus, along with registration material is available on the Society's URL, www.metaphysicalsociety.org

The room for the Thursday evening meeting of the Society for the Study of Process Philosophies is the Seminar Room of the Philosophy Department (214, Bowden Hall on the quadrangle).

All of the sessions of the MSA will be held in room 206 of White Hall, slightly off the quadrangle.

2) The cutoff date for our special rate at the University Inn has been extended two weeks to February 24. Please make your reservations mentioning the MSA for this reduction.

N.B. The University Inn on North Decatur Rd. across from the Law School must not be confused with the Emory Inn on Clifton Rd. across from the C.D.C. The latter is much more expensive and does not offer us a reduced rate.

3) Because of a generous subsidy from the Office of the Provost, we are able to keep the price of the banquet (including wine) at \$35.00 and have the use of the beautiful Houston Mill House for this event. Please make your dinner reservation early.

4) Transportation Saturday evening from White Hall to H.M.H for the banquet and from there to the University Inn will be provided. There is also ample parking at H.M.H. for those with their own automobiles.

5) Parking on campus on Saturday is free but on Friday will be limited to visitor parking for which you must pay a fee. Since this is still Spring Break, there should be no problem finding a parking place.
